

# Sheridan Community Schools



- **Elementary Classrooms and information:**
- We have space available – up to 6 rooms (120 students at 20 per class)
- Adding on a “wing” to SES
  
- Class Size and Number of Teachers – Aug. 22, 2022
  - Kindergarten – 4 teachers / 22-23 Total students 82 (21 average) / 26-27 Total: 93 (23)
  - 1st – 4 teachers / 22-23 Total Students 82 (21 average) / 26-27 Total: 90 (22)
  - 2nd – 4 teachers / 22-23 Total Students 85 (21 average) / 26-27 Total: 92 (23)
  - 3rd – 4 teachers / 22-23 Total Students 85 (21 average) / 26-27 Total: 94(23)
  - 4th – 3 teachers / 22-23 Total Students 73 (24 average) / 26-27 Total:92 (23 –4 teach)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – 4 teachers / 22-23 Total Students 88 (22 average) / 26-27 Total: 95 (24)
    - We have classroom aides in K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade

# Sheridan Community Schools



- **Demographic Study Thoughts:**
- Growth from 22-23 to 26-27:
  - Elementary: Projected growth 59 (93 by 31-32)
    - Actual 492 compared to 497 projected
  - Middle School: Projected growth -2 (54 by 31-32)
    - Actual 257 compared to 246 projected
  - High School: Projected growth 14 (44 by 31-32)
    - Actual 335 compared to 323 projected

Our Demographic Study DOES NOT include this

- This project is run by the County
- Highway 38 / 47 – completed in 2025
- 1,000 Homes have been approved?? – Just one plan
- Mixed homes and commercial
- Impact will start in about 10 years



# SHS and SMS - We are preparing

- Current plan is to update our extra curricular facilities first
  - Health rooms in new area open up space in the academic area
- We need the space to allow for new programming
- More students involved in internships – reduces spacing
- More students utilizing online opportunities for classes we can't provide
- Approved – PHASE I
  - Auxiliary Gym
  - Weight room (existing weight room become classrooms)
  - This summer we moved the weight room to the MS gym
- **This money CAN NOT BE USED FOR SALARIES nor is it from the REFERENDUM**

# Sheridan Community Schools



- Outdoor – **Phase II and III - currently estimating costs**
  - Auditorium Upgrades
  - Softball – Turf infield
  - Soccer – grass
    - One or two fields
  - Buildings and facilities
    - Concession
    - Restroom
  - Currently working a long-term future design
    - This includes where a NEW SCHOOL would go

# Sheridan Community Schools



## SAFETY LEVELS

- We have moved to a 4 level system that allows us to be consistent with other Hamilton County Schools and first responders
- Placed in all learning spaces and offices, as well as throughout the hallways of each building

## A.L.I.C.E.

- Response to a violent intruder
- We will be implementing the ALICE Protocol training to ALL staff this school year

# Sheridan Community Schools



## VAPE DETECTORS

- We received a grant through the HCCOAOD for 6 Vape Sensors
- We are installing the sensors in 6 bathrooms throughout the High School
- Pending response of the vape sensors in the High School - we would like to install additional ones at the Middle School in the future
- Wiring for the vape sensors was completed on Friday, August 5th

## CAMERA AUDIT

- A camera audit was completed for the High School and Middle School

## RE-KEYING THE DISTRICT

- We are waiting to receive a quote to re-key the High School and the Middle School
- Our goal is for every employee to have a max of 2 keys to get into the district. One for the HS/MS building and one for the Elementary building

## BADGES AND CARD READERS

- We are replacing the old card readers and installing additional readers at doors with frequent use
- We will be including the safety levels on the back of all of our newly issued badges
- Requested a quote for door alerts
- Propped doors
- Side door usage (students letting late students in)
- Failed usage of inactive badges

## SAFETY POLICIES

- We are reviewing several safety policies that will be ready for the First Reading in September

## 3 YEAR PLAN

- We are developing a 3 year plan for multiple safety initiatives that we would like to implement at Sheridan Community Schools


# Sheridan Community Schools



## Solar Statistics

- 11,536,693 kwh of solar has been produced in 4.5 years
- Total Savings to date is \$ 1,361,329 dollars at todays 11.8 cents per kwh
- Achieved production is 98 percent of expectation
- The 11,536,693 kwh produced to date is equivalent to powering all the homes of Sheridan for a year
- Sheridan's board and Administration vision in renewable energy has secured a major financial net metering benefits. Sheridan's early adoption will get a one for one credit on kwh solar power when solar over produces what the schools load is untill 2048.
